Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- 1. Provides crisis intervention and advocacy to residents in all shelter programs.
- 2. Provides transportation to residents.
- 3. Create a medical/dental assessment tool for each client and their family on admission to Friendship Home.
- 4. Assists clients in connecting with healthcare opportunities and resources.
- 5. Build collaborative support with community health care providers.
- 6. Embraces innovative ideas and community-based solutions that enhance traditional health care and/or behavioral health care models.
- 7. Creates awareness of childhood toxic stress, prenatal care, and healthy birth outcomes.
- 8. Promotes early childhood education best practices.
- 9. Assists families in establishing dependable, affordable, compassionate medical homes.
- 10. Provides basic education regarding the dynamics of domestic violence, the impact on children, non-violent parenting techniques, etc.
- 11. Review program logs and document interactions with residents.
- 12. Maintains records and statistics as part of the Agency's Program Evaluation system.
- 13. Assists with the training of new staff and volunteers.
- 14. Ensures adherence to shelter rules, policies, and procedures.
- 15. Make educational/informational presentations to community groups and interested parties.
- 16. Assists with special projects and tasks the Program Director assigns.
